**North Carolina 511 Information Line**

511 is an abbreviated dialing code for travelers to access highway, multi-modal, and other pertinent travel information via landline or wireless phones. By collecting travel information, the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) is able to disseminate travel information like construction, incidents, traffic, and transit, so that the public can make educated decisions about travel times, routes, and modes.

**Types of Information Available**

- Traffic incidents, major closures, and construction on Interstates, US Routes, and State Routes in NC
- Weather Conditions Statewide
- Amber Alerts
- Links to Neighboring States' 511 Phone Systems
